DID YOU KNOW?

Texas Ops consists of four facets...

- Processing (Intake)
- Authorizations
- Physician Liaison
- Staffing



Processing

The processing team's main goal is to get in touch with families and staff for children as quickly as possible. They follow a strict timeline and typically have a 24 hour turnaround period

Anthorizations

The authorization team's main goal is to obtain medicaid authorization for a potential patient. Texas has a large amount of MCO's (medicaid payors)

Physician Liaisons

The physician liaison team is responsible for obtaining signed order forms from primary care physicians. Their goal is to obtain paperwork as quickly as possibly, so that our amazing therapists can start doing visits! Even if we have received authorization, without a signed order, we cannot start conducting visits

Staffing

Our staffing team is responsible for our new hire caseloads, as well as restaffing for therapists who have left the company, and had an active caseload. Our staffing team brings our clinicians and patients together
