
What's the difference?	Private Duty	Skilled Nursing
For clients who meet medical necessity criteria	\checkmark	⋖
Usually 8 or more hours per day	√	
For intermittent or part-time, typically with an end-point of treatment		⋖
Require individualized, continuous, nursing care	\checkmark	
One-to-one basis	✓	
Provides direct nursing care, and caregiver training and education.	⋖	⋖
Provided by a licensed nurse	⋖	⋖
Delaying skilled intervention may affect the health status of the client	✓	✓

All Nursing Services Require:

- Services must be prescribed by a phsylcian
- Provide documentation to support medical necessity
- Requires ongoing and frequent skilled intervention

Private Duty Nursing (PDN) is not:

- Approved for respite care only.
- Personal Care Services
- Custodial Care
